

## RULES

The decision of the judges is final.

The show is open to members and non-members.

The blooms in classes 1 to 22 inclusive must have been grown outside by the exhibitor.

Entries in class 23 must have been grown by the exhibitor or tended by the exhibitor for at least 6 months.

Exhibitors must provide their own vases – any type.  
NB A vase is a container whose height is 3 times its width.

Daffodil foliage is permitted in classes 1 to 16 and 21 to 22 inclusive.

**Entry fee is 25p per exhibit. No fee for children's entries.**

Please bring and stage your entries as early as possible and register them with the Show Secretary Mr B Quibell.

Exhibits must be staged before 12 noon and may not be removed before 4.30pm. Stands must be cleared by 5 pm.

Only people bringing entries will be admitted to the hall between 10am and 12 noon on the day of the show.

For this show, DAFFODIL includes any variety of daffodil or narcissus.

Only one exhibit in each class per person will score points.

Cups and trophies must be returned in good, presentable condition to the Show Secretary before the next Show.

20. A Vase of Daffodils arranged for quality and effect. Own foliage
21. 2 Vases of Daffodils, Cup varieties, 2 distinct varieties, 3 blooms per vase
22. An arrangement of Mixed Spring Flowers
23. Any Home Grown plant in a pot (maximum diameter 10 inches / 25 centimetre)
